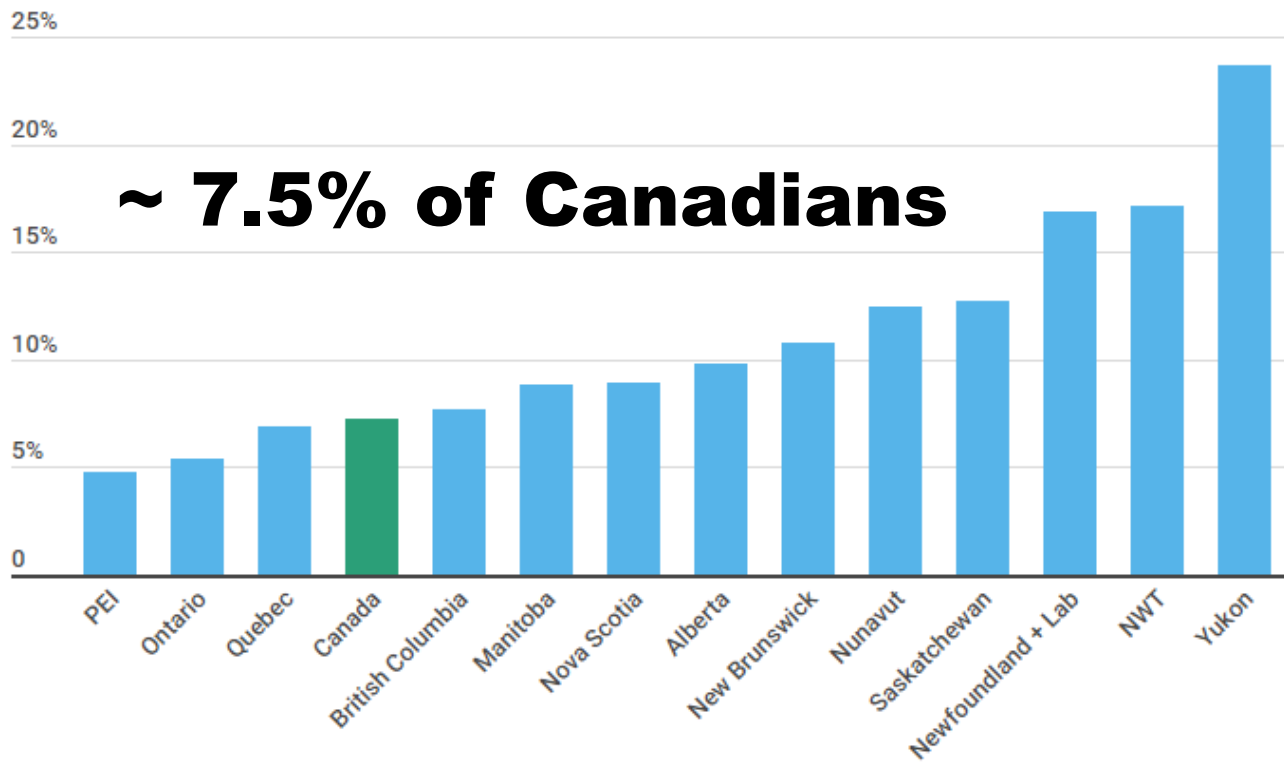

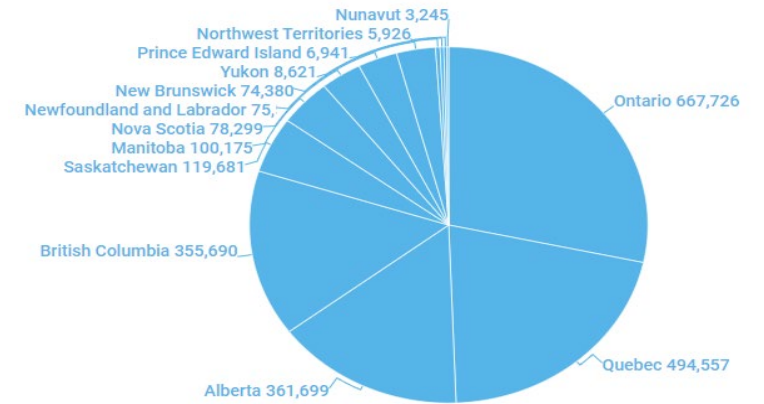

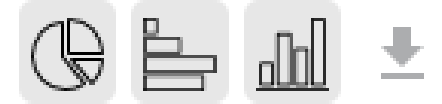
On Average how many Rounds do you Shoot per Visit



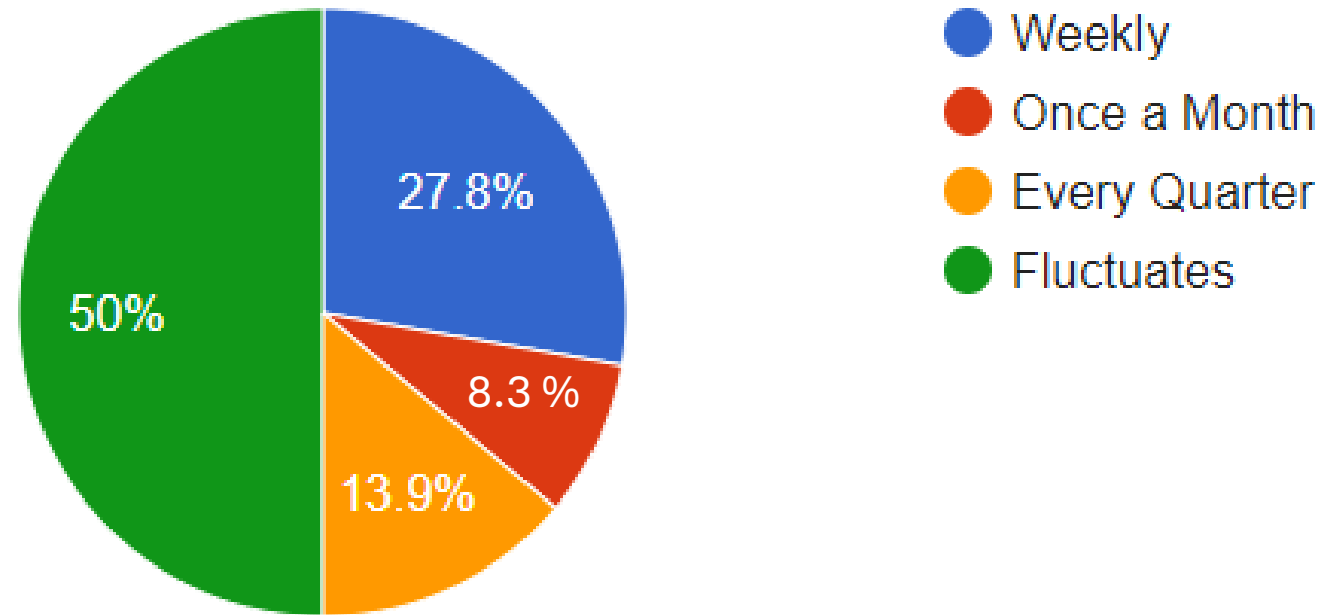

GENERAL DISCUSSION



CORONATION STATUS – CLUB&PROPERTY

CONTEXT

In continuous conversations around this topic over the past many AGM's – the Coronation is in place that in the event of the Club closure the Club and all its assets would be donated to a Named Beneficiary and not the Town of Huntsville – HPRC would control the Coronation transfer ... This has been an ongoing item for the past 3 years

STATUS

The Club to date has had our Law Firm lead this area

At this time there are many organizations working through the Legal aspects in the same situation as our Club including Firearms Safety Education Service and the NFA

We are leveraging these organizations to spend their legal funds to than establish a **precedent** that our Club can simply leverage and fall under. This is the best use of our time and money at this point.

There is no further action required in this area other than waiting for a new precedent to be set by other “like-minded” organizations
The executive remains seized in the endeavor

STATUS OF THE SAFETY COMMITTEE

CONTEXT

The Club in the last few years instituted a new Probation/Six Shoot review process for new members. At one point 2 years ago, the executive was reduced to a president and a treasurer. There was no capacity on the executive to handle the review, tracking, follow-up, execution etc. A new committee was put together of non-executives to help execute the increase in workload required to maintain the updated Probation Program

STATUS

As discussed during the AGM, the number of probation issues from 2024 vs 2023 has risen. As part of reviewing the history and taking lessons learned, it was determined that our CLS program & some of our process need a revamp.

Until we finalize these decisions and execute (see the results of change), it will than update what is required of the Safety Committee etc -

We don't put the cart before the horse - expect to sort this in Q1

ACTION LEAGUE – MATCH PARTICIPATION WITH OTHER SELECTED CLUBS

CONTEXT

Prior to Covid; HPRC along with several other arranged area Clubs allowed each other their Holster Certified/Approved members to participate in each other's Club Monthly Action League matches

STATUS

HPRC is going to re-start this existing program; leveraging the same rules as Pre-Covid days

We will be taking the process slow and first working with the Gravenhurst Range

The Action League owns the process; as approved by the Executive



MEMBERSHIP RENEWAL DATES DISCUSSION ...

WHICH THAN LEAD TO A **MOTION**

The Challenge: We scramble each year in January to renew all our members. Until we fully understand how many members are not returning; we do not know how many new memberships we can offer

We have too many things going on at once (renewals, recruiting and onboarding) The result of which has us trying to recruit and schedule well into the new year

Most people understand that Clubs start the renewal membership process post January 1st each year; but it becomes a challenge for those waiting to find out if they can Join/Leave a Club

The Chance: separate our Renewals from our Recruiting & Onboarding

MEMBERSHIP RENEWAL DATE CHANGE

CONTEXT



STATUS

Collecting Membership Renewals at the end of the year presents a challenge for lining up New Memberships for the new year; we end up onboarding new members well into late spring

Potential members do not know if there “is room for them” at our Club until early in new year; we could easily lose those folks to other clubs or not leaving the one they are at – Need to queue up members earlier in the year

HPRC will change Membership Renewal Date to Oct 31st in 2025

This allows us to than know how many available Memberships are available well ahead of the new year

A thorough explanation of the updated process will be provided to all Members well ahead of time

MOTION

EXTENDING MEMBERSHIP SIZE FROM 200 TO 225 WITH A “PRIORITY SPONSORED” APPROACH

CONTEXT

Club is currently at the 200 Members Capacity. We feel that we can support taking on 25 more members without a major impact to busy times etc

We want to bring in “like-minded” new members and the best way to do that is via Sponsored Members; meaning you must have an existing HPRC member vouch for your application to HPRC (just for this new group of 25)

Enable this “Sponsored” group of 25 now versus waiting until post Jan/2025
